

TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS

&

HUMANITARIAN PAROLE via Operation Allies Welcome (OAW)

TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS (TPS)

Apply for TPS once in the US

Allows you to stay in the US
for duration of TPS designation

Temporary Status
(Does not lead to lawful permanent residency)

Up to 18 months
(of designated grant period)

Extension or Re-Designation
possible but not guaranteed
(as decided by Department of Homeland Security)

Eligible for Work Authorization
(via Form I-765)

Protected from removal proceeding
(unless TPS is terminated based on criminal or
security issues)

Can apply for travel permit to travel outside of US
(via Form I-131)

Eligible for federal benefits
if granted and maintaining Humanitarian Parole

OAW HUMANITARIAN PAROLE (HP)

Received Humanitarian Parole
under Operation Allies Welcome (OAW)

Allowed to enter and remain in the US
for a temporary duration

Temporary Status
(Does not lead to lawful permanent residency)

Up to 24 months
(from arrival)

Re-parole not currently available
(as decided by the Department of Homeland Security)

Eligible for Work Authorization
(via Form I-765)

Can be subject to removal proceedings
if violate conditions of parole

Cannot travel outside of US

Eligible for federal benefits
if requirements met
