TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS (TPS) OAW HUMANITARIAN PAROLE (HP) **Received Humanitarian Parole** Apply for TPS once in the US under Operation Allies Welcome (OAW) Allows you to stay in the US Allowed to enter and remain in the US for duration of TPS designation for a temporary duration **Temporary Status Temporary Status** (Does not lead to lawful permanent residency) (Does not lead to lawful permanent residency) Up to 18 months Up to 24 months (of designated grant period) (from arrival) **Extension or Re-Designation** Re-parole not currently available possible but not guaranteed (as decided by the Department of Homeland Security) (as decided by Department of Homeland Security) **Eligible for Work Authorization Eligible for Work Authorization** (via Form I-765) (via Form I-765)

Protected from removal proceeding (unless TPS is terminated based on criminal or security issues)

Can apply for travel permit to travel outside of US (via Form I-131)

Eligible for federal benefits if granted and maintaining Humanitarian Parole

Cannot travel outside of US

if violate conditions of parole

Can be subject to removal proceedings

Eligible for federal benefits if requirements met
